

Environmental Enhancement Rebate Project Policies

What is this? A rebate program where receipts for items approved by the Town of Penhold that aid in conserving our environment may be submitted for a rebate on your utility bill.

How does this work? Purchase an approved item that is energy efficient, submit the receipt to Town Office and wait to see the rebate on your Town Utility Bill

Who does this apply to? All residents of the Town of Penhold

When is this good for? Receipts dating back to January 1, 2009 may be submitted to the town for a rebate as outlined below. The program runs until December 31, 2009 or until the funds are used up.

Item	Rebate	Amount Allowable
Low Flow / Dual Flush toilet	\$50.00 / \$100.00	max 2
Shower Head	\$10.00	max 2
Rain Barrel	\$30.00	max 1
Composter	\$50.00	max 1

Rebate cannot exceed more than 50% of the cost of the item

Conditions

- Original receipt is required and must be verified at town office
- Proof that the item is energy efficient / environmentally friendly
- Rebates only apply to the property owner
- Replacement of toilets and showerheads are eligible
- Rebate is applied to the utility bill only
- Homeowners that do not have a utility account (ie. Condo Owners) may receive the rebate in the form of a cheque
- Tax account must be current to receive the rebate
- Proof of disposal of replaced toilet is required

Disposal for toilets will be provided at Town Office
