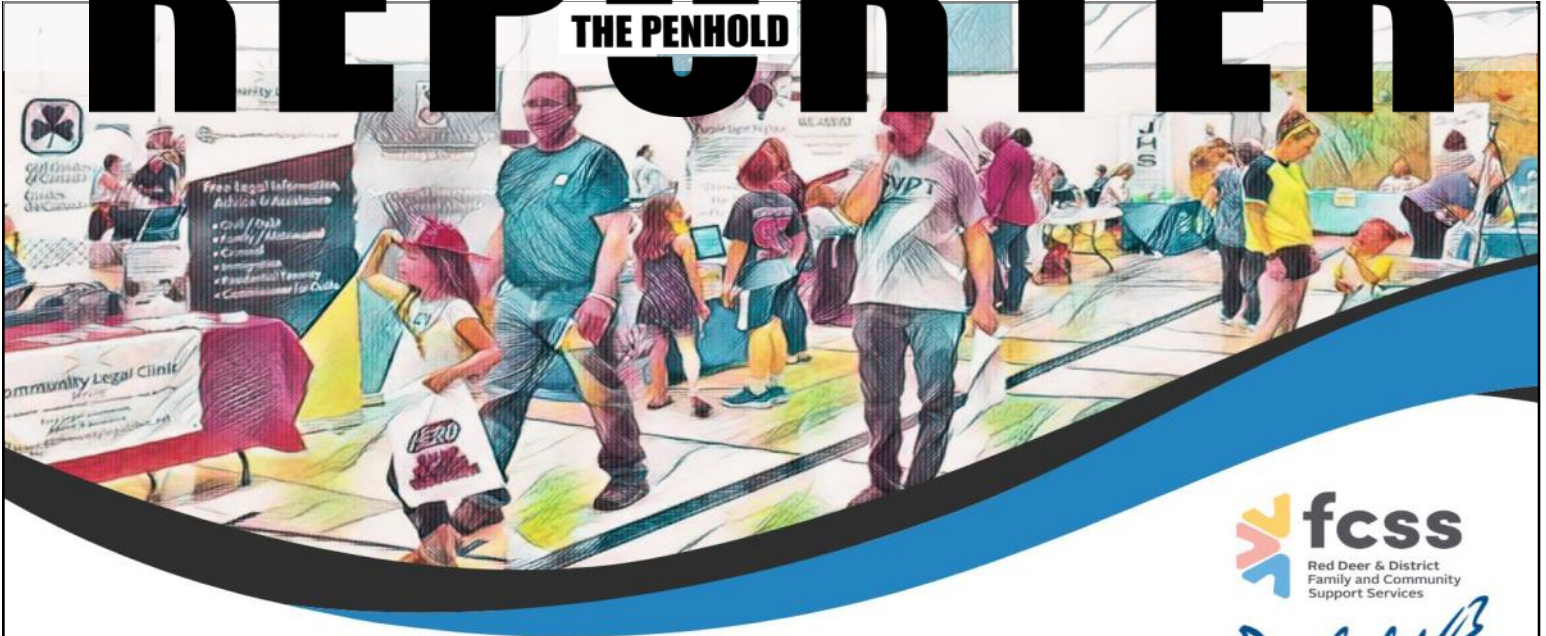

COUNCIL CORNER

Key Notes From July 14th, Council Meeting

CAO Report:

Met with Regional Manager from Alberta Transportation and Economic corridors to discuss several key intersections in town.

Outstanding projects being worked on: Intermunicipal Collaborative Framework (ICF) with Red Deer County; Offsite Fee review and updates; 2025 municipal elections.

Multiplex Report:

Staff removed the ice and completed all maintenance. The ice is back in for this coming season and hockey camps are now occurring.

Gymnasium floors have been refurbished giving it that fresh new look.

Fitness continues to have large numbers of participants in the fitness programs.

Operations Report:

Summer maintenance is occurring throughout town for water valve exercising, repairs, sewer repairs etc.

Alleys and potholes have been a focus over the past few weeks.

Sports fields, Parks and Splash Park are all highly utilized with operations running smoothly for the most part.

Check out the new basketball nets located at Lincoln Rec Outdoor Rink.

The Disc Golf Course continues to be worked on with the final hole installations occurring soon.

The final asphalt lift on Emma Street is now completed.

The RV Park is steadily booked and continues to show well for Penhold. Great job to our Operations staff for their work on operating and maintaining the Park until the new Caretakers started.

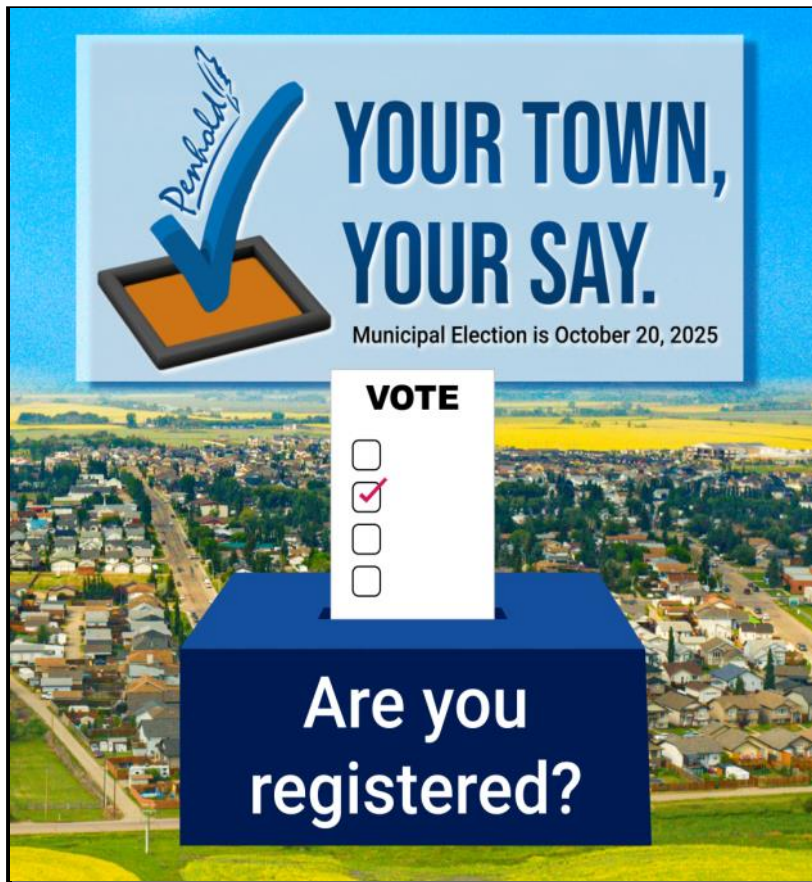

NEW for 2025: Legislative changes in 2024 require municipalities to work with Elections Alberta to maintain a Permanent Electors Register.

Registering early makes the voting process faster and easier, because you won't have to register at the polling station on Election Day.

Your privacy is important. VoterLink is a provincial registration system, and your information will be shared with your municipality for electoral purposes only.

The Splash Park is now open for the season!
Operating Hours 11:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. daily.
The Lincoln Street Rec Centre building will be open for bathroom use during the operating hours of the park.

Splash Park Rules:

- The Splash Park is an unsupervised area.
- Parents / Caregivers: Do not leave children unattended!
- No abusive language or objectionable behaviour.
- No littering, please use garbage cans.
- No pets allowed; leashed, or unleashed.
- No wheeled items (bicycles, strollers, skateboards, scooters) should be on Splash Pad.
- Washrooms are inside the Rec Centre.

The Splash Park attendant is on site for Splash Park operations, not supervision.

Please be considerate when using the Splash Park as this is a re-circulating water system & all water that goes down the drain must be treated.

Unwanted substances can cause difficulties with the treatment system

resulting in shutdowns. If the system is down, it is generally due to an unbalance in the chemical treatment system or clogged filters. Please be patient with the attendant while they try to rectify the problem.

The water in this splash park is treated and recirculated to help conserve resources

Just like pool water, Splash Park water should not be consumed

Yard Waste Compost

The Yard Waste Compost is scheduled to be open until the end of October, weather dependant. Bins are located at the future site of the Operations/Protective Services Building located north of Hwy 42, across from the Oxford Water Reservoir. Accepted items include grass clippings, leaves, and branches (no longer than 4 feet or 1 inch in diameter). Grass must be dumped out of garbage bags and into the bins. **NO BAGS, GARBAGE OR ANIMAL FECES is to be placed in the yard waste compost bins.** Please be considerate, removing bags after they are in the bins is labour intensive. Please don't add to already full bins, they get checked and emptied on a regular basis. This is a great service to have, please help us keep it available!

Reminder to Comply with the Outdoor Watering Restrictions

The Utility Bylaw indicates: Outdoor watering restrictions will be in effect at all times.

Odd/Even street addresses shall determine days watering shall be allowed. The numerical address of which (excluding street name) ends in odd number may water on each odd day of the month, and the numerical address of which (excluding street name) ending in an even number may water each even day of the month. Outdoor sprinkling includes vehicle washing, lawn watering or other irrigation purposes on any day of the month.

Some tips to help you conserve water are:

- Set your sprinkler to avoid watering patios, driveways, and sidewalks.
- Water back from the tops of slopes, as water will run down the slope and seep into the soil.
- Sweep your driveway and walkway instead of washing with a hose.
- Apply a maximum of 2.5cm (1 in) of water, including rainfall, to your lawn each week.

To Flush or Not to Flush

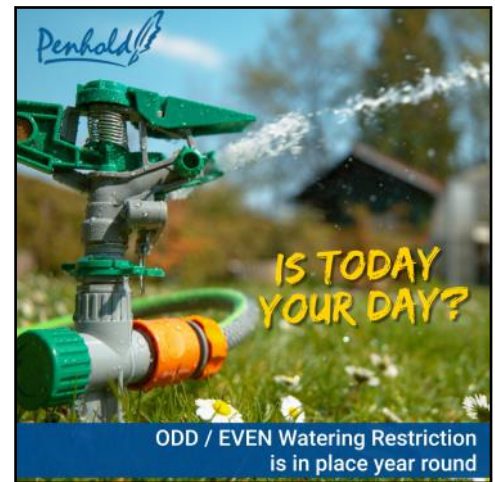
Just because the package says "flushable" doesn't mean it's true. Many items marketed as disposable and/or flushable do not degrade like toilet paper, and they wind up clogging pipes, tangling pumps, and causing sewer backups into streets, businesses, and homes.

Our sewers are designed to dispose of very specific things. Using your toilet for disposal of many modern products will often result in blockages. The drains that connect your home to the main sewer are only big enough to carry water, toilet paper and human waste – pipes are typically 4 inches. Operations Staff maintain the sewers to ensure we always have free flowing wastewater disposal. Please consider them and their safety when choosing to flush or not to flush.

What not to flush:

- Diapers (cloth, disposable, "flushable")
- Facial tissues
- Baby wipes, disinfectant wipes, moist wipes, etc.
- Toilet bowl scrub pads
- Swiffer's
- Napkins (paper or cloth), paper towels
- Dental floss
- Egg shells, nutshells, and coffee grounds
- Fats, oils, and greases
- Food items containing seeds and peelings
- Hair
- Sanitary napkins, tampons, condoms, or any non-organic material
- Vitamins, medicines, or other pharmaceuticals
- Wash cloths, towels, rags (any cloth item)
- Clothing
- Sheet plastic, or plastic of any kind
- Needles or other sharp objects
- Cigarette Butts

2025 Tree/ Shrub Planting

- Penhold Commons around the storm pond - Critter's Corner

The areas have been staked identifying where the different trees/shrubs will be
planted. Please help ensure the work can proceed as scheduled by leaving the stakes alone.

A company will be assisting the Town with landscaping and planting. They will be working with equipment so
please be cautious and respectful when near them, keeping in mind it helps immensely to make eye contact with
operators when near them and give them room to work.

Disc Golf Update

In the fall of 2024, a 9-hole disc golf course was installed around the Critter's Corner playground. Baskets and temporary tees were put in place. The permanent tee pads are still to come (2-3 years down the road).

Town staff were advised by those who have developed courses in the past to give at least a 2-year trial run before installing any permanent tee pads/

signage. This allows time for any adjustments to be made for safety, residents who live beside the course can express any concerns that may arise and overall feedback from users as to whether the course flows nice or needs tweaking can be assessed.

Three practice baskets were also installed in Hayter Park in 2024. These baskets were purchased prior to 2024 and after talking with developers, staff were strongly advised not to use these baskets for the main 9 or 18-hole course as they are not professionally made. Operations decided to make use of them by having practice baskets where learners or young kids could develop skills in a quiet area. These baskets, located in Hayter Park, are not intended to be part of the 9 or 18-hole course.

In July 2025, the town received nine more baskets which were installed around the Penhold Commons Storm Pond/ Ball Diamonds/ Lucina St Pond. Temporary tees (rocks with numbers) will be used for this area as well. There are more potential safety concerns with this course because of the location and higher use of those walking, biking and users visiting the area.

Operations staff will be adjusting the location of these baskets and tees as needed. Trees and shrubs are being planted within the Penhold Commons Storm Pond area in the next two years, which may affect the course over time as well.

This 9-hole course is intended to be more challenging than Critter's Corner but may be used to extend into an 18-hole course for those who desire to enjoy both. Plans for this course also include some or most of the holes with two different tee pad locations/ or basket locations for each hole. Some reasons for this are to :provide town staff with the ability to change the course occasionally, encouraging returning users; prevent too much wear at the sites; and create additional challenges, such as throwing the disc over the pond or not (some do not like to chance losing their discs in water).

What still needs to be completed?

- Permanent tee pads
- Signage with maps and distances for each hole
- Disc Golf App with the town's courses and a link on town website when the course is fully developed

The disc golf is a great addition to the Town of Penhold and Town staff are making every effort in working towards a safe and enjoyable course. It is exciting to see all the positive feedback and possibilities for tournaments, etc. as it unfolds! Please contact the Town if you have any further questions or concerns.

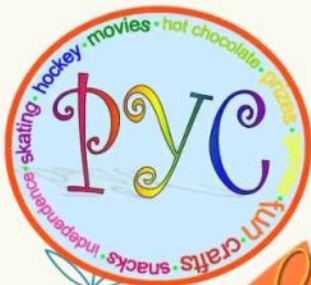

Has your child had their annual eye exam? It's important to do before they start school!

Eye See...Eye Learn™

is a program that provides kindergarten-aged students with a comprehensive eye exam from an optometrist. There is Alberta Health coverage towards your child's eye exams up to age 19. **If required, kindergarten-aged students also receive a free pair of eyeglasses.**

How kindergarten-aged students participate

Step 1 Parents can find a participating optometrist at optometrists.ab.ca. Click on Find an Optometrist and **Eye See...Eye Learn™**, then enter your postal code to find a doctor close to you. **Call and book an appointment.**

Step 2 See your optometrist for the eye exam. Have your health card ready. There is **Alberta Health coverage towards your child's eye exams up to age 19.**

Step 3 If required, kindergarten-aged students will **receive a free pair of eyeglasses.** Ask to see the frame selection available. The optometrist will order your glasses for you.

***Free glasses are covered by a one year manufacturer's warranty.**

Who can participate?

Eye See...Eye Learn™ is available to all **kindergarten-aged students** in Alberta. It's important to address eye health and vision problems before children begin school.

Children are eligible from August until they begin grade one.
