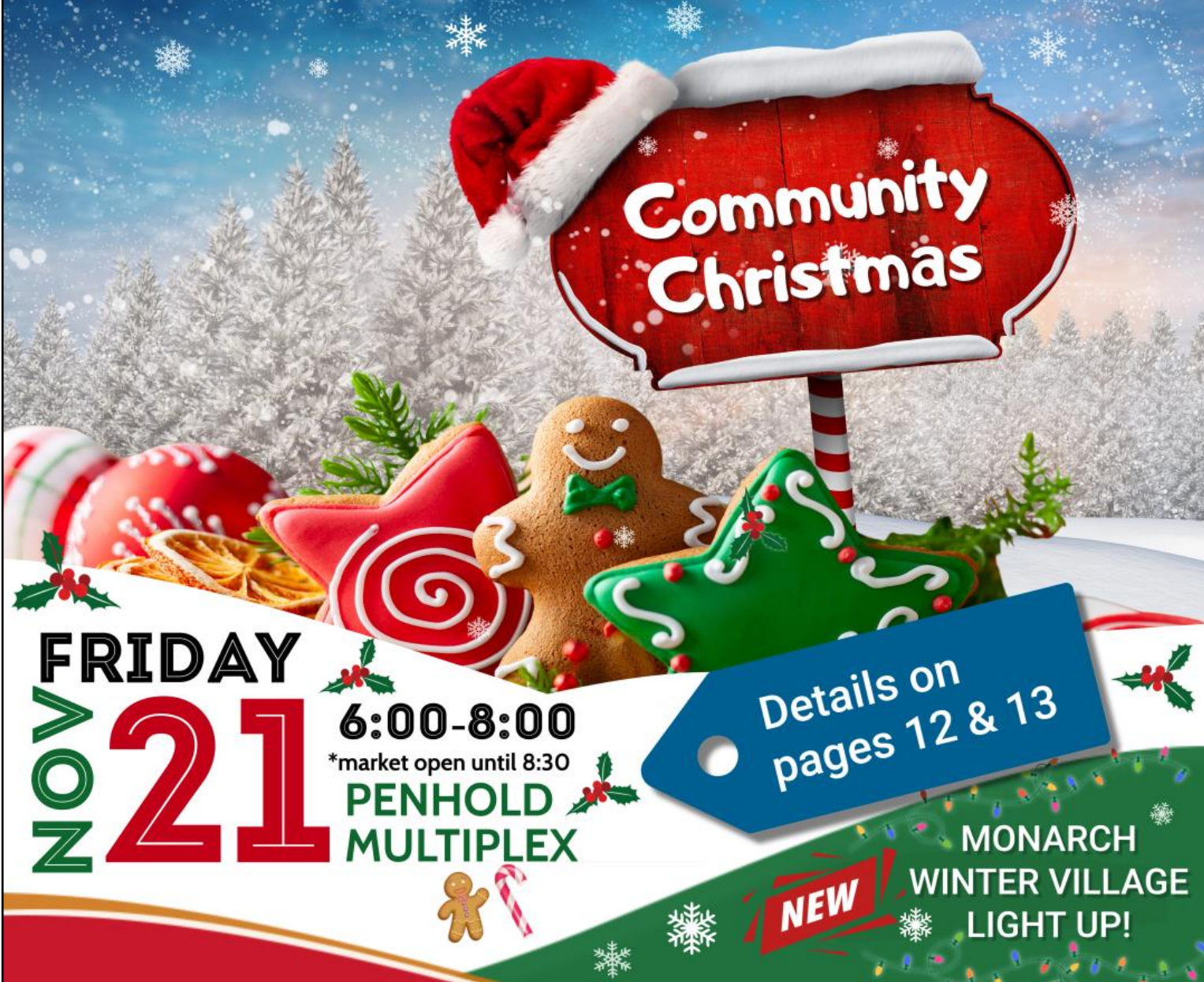

COUNCIL CORNER



The 2025 Municipal Election may be behind us, but the work for Council and Administration is just beginning as they set the course for the next four years.

As of October 24 at 12:00 p.m., the election results became official, confirming the members of Town Council for the 2025–2029 term. According to information from Elections Alberta and local Form 13 Elector Forms, there were 2,646 eligible voters in Penhold. Of those, 667 residents cast their ballots, representing a 25% voter turnout.

OPERATIONS

Snow Removal

Our Operations Staff make every effort to ensure that our streets are clear of snow and ice during the winter months. Please be patient as we complete this process. Snow plowing and/or removal on streets will be started after a heavy snowfall (15cm) or once accumulations have reached 15cm.

The priority areas are as follows:

Priority one includes main thoroughfares and bus routes.

Priority two includes businesses, streets, and avenues.

Priority three includes Closes, Courts, and Places – These are cleared once all other major areas are complete.

Snow removal may be conducted outside of priorities listed if deemed necessary. The snow removal priority map is available on the Town of Penhold Website.

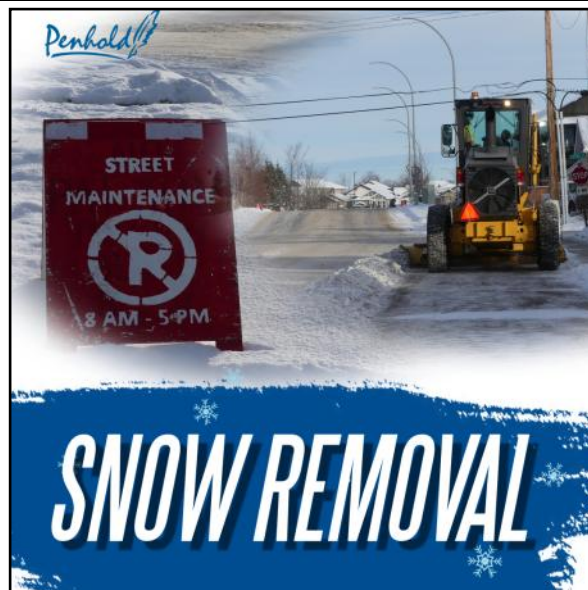
Alleys are not listed as a priority and are maintained as time and conditions permit.

This process may take three weeks, or longer, depending on snow fall, conditions, and workload. Should another 15cm of snow accumulate during the snow removal process, priorities will shift back to one and two.

Snow will be windrowed until removal is possible. Where applicable, snow will be windrowed to the side of the street without a sidewalk.

Residents are reminded to remove any driveway curb ramps you have, as they hinder snow removal.

Please use extra care when approaching snow removal equipment as visibility is limited and equipment may stop and/or back up suddenly.



No Parking Signs

Operations will make every attempt to put out no parking signs the day before snow removal is planned. Please be courteous to Town staff as well as your neighbours by refraining from parking on the road during the hours posted. Vehicles are considered towable if they are not in accordance with the posted street sign (Traffic Bylaw 754.2018 Section 18.8). If Operations are not able to complete snow removal on the day planned, the signs will remain up until removal is completed.

If you are unsure when snow removal is taking place, please call Operations at 403-886-3282. Signs are placed out prior to 4:30pm the day before maintenance begins. Updates to snow removal will also be made available on the Town of Penhold website. You can also receive updates to your email by signing up for the Town E-News.

Storm Pond Safety

The Penhold Commons Pond Aeration system runs year-round and assists with the natural oxygenation process of the water body to help combat harsh winter conditions. This will result in open water throughout the winter and thin ice. Signs have been placed in the area, but we ask that people stay off this pond as well as all other storm ponds throughout town as water may be flowing underneath the surface and the ice levels are not monitored.



Lincoln Street Storm Pond is a designated and licensed snow dumping site for the Operations Department. Trucks and equipment are using the site while snow removal is in progress. Please avoid using the area during this time. **The storm pond on Lincoln Street is part of the Town's storm infrastructure and not meant for recreational use.**



TOWN OF PENHOLD BYLAW NO 799/2021 COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW SECTION 4 - SNOW REMOVAL

All persons owning property or occupying premises in the Town, shall remove and clear away all snow, ice and/or slush, dirt and other obstructions from the sidewalk situated on land adjoining the property owned or occupied by them within seventy-two (72) hours of the time that such snow, ice and/or slush, dirt or other obstruction was deposited thereon.

The Town may, after the expiration of seventy-two (72) hours, remove and clean away all snow, ice and/or slush, dirt and other obstructions required to be removed by Section 4(1) and charge the expenses to the owner or occupant. If the cost of such work against the owner(s) or person in default, is not paid within sixty (60) days, such expenses shall be charged against the property as a special assessment to be recovered in another manner such as other taxes pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000 c. M-26*.

An occupant, or owner(s), of a building within three (3.0) meters of a highway, shall remove snow or ice whenever it accumulates on the roof or eaves, or downspouts of the building to eliminate a potential danger to vehicles or pedestrians. While removing the snow or ice hazard, an occupant or owner(s) shall take due care and attention for the safety of vehicles or pedestrians passing.

No person shall place, or cause to be placed, upon any highway any snow, ice and/or slush, dirt or other obstruction.



(5) Any person who contravenes any part of Section 4 is guilty of an offence.

Christmas Lights on Trees on Boulevards

Some residents enjoy decorating trees within the boulevards with lights. This is acceptable; however, we ask that if residents choose to do this, they remove the Christmas lights off the trees prior to March 30 the following spring.

APPLICABLE FOR SPECIFIC VIOLATION TICKETS ISSUED NOV. 03 - DEC. 08, 2025 ONLY

The Community Peace Officers will once again be collecting toys for the Red Deer Christmas Bureau in lieu of payment for specific violation tickets issued November 3 through December 5, 2025.

If you receive a ticket during this time you can bring a new, unwrapped toy to the Town Office with a receipt showing the value is at least 80% the value of the fine instead of paying your fine.

If you have an **existing** Town of Penhold Pet License, you are eligible for the Early Renewal Discount if you renew your Pet License before Dec. 31. New tags are not required with renewals. **Early Renewal Discount applies on existing licenses only, new Pet Licenses do not qualify for renewal discount.*

If licenses are renewed October 1 to December 31, the following rates apply:

Unaltered Animal: \$30 Altered Animal: \$15

Put a **FREEZE** *on Winter Fires*

Home fires occur more in winter than in any other season. As you stay cozy and warm this winter, be fire smart!



Half of all home heating fires occur in December, January and February.



Heating equipment is involved in **1 in every 6** home fires and **1 in every 5** home fire deaths.



Keep anything that can burn **at least 3 feet** from any heat source like fireplaces, wood stoves, radiators or space heaters.



Keep portable generators **outside, away from windows, and as far away** from your home as possible.



Install and test carbon monoxide alarms **at least once a month.**



Plug only **1 heat-producing appliance** (like a space heater) into an electrical outlet at a time.



Have a qualified professional clean and inspect your chimney and vents **every year.**



Store cooled ashes in a tightly covered metal container, and keep it **outside at least 10 feet** from your home and any nearby buildings.

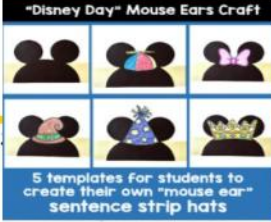
