COUNCIL CORNER

April 13, 2026 Council Meeting

Public Hearing for two zoning areas for Melcor Developments.

West of Suds Station north of Highway #42; and North of Oxford Blvd.

There was a good presence from the surrounding residents. Key issues raised were potential street parking concerns and when will a park be developed. Public Hearing started at 6:02 pm and went until 7:06pm

Presentations: Town of Penhold 2025 Audited Financial Statement

Mr. Ohene-Adjei, CPA, Senior Manager, Pivotal Chartered Professional Accountants. key points made were:

Town remains in a strong and stable financial position

The Town designated \$282,840 from utilities recovery to designated future projects; this left the town with a small deficiency \$163,328. The Town's debt situation has dropped down to 12%

Overall, the town has low debt levels, relative modern infrastructure, and continue to invest in key assets to serve the community.

Bylaw 843/2026 - Land Use Bylaw amendment for rezoning two areas as identified above was given second and third reading for approval.

Development:

- 7 new single-family home permits have been pulled since the last meeting.
- Subdivision proposal in Melcor includes 39 more lots including single family small lot, large lot and duplexes.
- Council approved and development to occur this summer.

Multiplex:

- Penhold Multiplex saw 22,756 people come into our building in March.
- The Fitness Centre continues to see great responses for classes and working out.

Operations:

- Both water reservoirs had the Aquatec Diving team checking and cleaning the tanks.
- RV Park is now open for bookings. We saw a 50% increase over last year when we opened registrations.
- RV Park opens May 1st
- Sani dump is opening in the next couple weeks.
- Compost bins will be out in May.

New Business:

- 36 residential lot subdivisions were approved by Council within the Melcor development.
- Urban Forest Management Plan proposal through FCM was approved by Council to proceed. This will give the town a tree inventory data set with modelling and analysis of our tree health and future planning. Kudos to Lynnette for finding the grant and both Lynnette & Nancy for pulling the application together.
- Town has entered a 3-year contract with Ice Tech Refrigeration Inc for the servicing of the Town's arena ice plant.
- Council is pleased to support and announce that Mayor Mike will be putting his name forward to be on the FCM Board of Directors for the 2026 - 2028 term.

April 27, 2026 Council Meeting

2026 taxes are now set: Good News Story for Penhold

Penhold has lowered our tax rates for residential from 7.83 to 7.29% This reduction in the tax rate helps residents realize only minor changes to their 2026 taxes. There has been an increase in school and policing costs that on average pushed taxes slightly up by 3.2% on average. (see page 5 for more details)

Key Points from the tax presentation:

- Tax rates for residential went down while commercial remained the same as last year.
- School costs and policing both went up by double digits (percentage wise).
- Municipal residential taxes in Penhold, on an average home in 2026, is lower than they were ten years ago.
- Provincial charges have pushed the tax rates up.
- Your tax bill represents 42% of the total funds that must go back to the province as requisitions.
- 58% of your tax bill covers all the town’s services provided to our residents.
- Tax notices and assessment notices will be going out in May.
- The complete presentation is available for review on the Town’s website.

Council approved the 10-year capital and operational planning document.

The Fall Festival team is in search of someone new to host the Show and Shine for this coming year.

Parkland Community Planning Services has now closed its doors. Several communities are in search of finding someone to provide ongoing planning services and the ability to handle appeal processes.

Penhold, in partnership with Bentley and Clive, are moving to Growth Strategic Framework that will review key areas for potential growth within the communities by identifying and recommending key areas that each can focus on. This work will be carried out by Urban Systems with anticipated completion by the end of 2026.

Penhold will be submitting two resolutions at this year's AB Munis Convention along with supporting a third resolution. Resolutions are:

- Raising the threshold for acceptance to bring a stronger mandate by the association in presenting to the province.
- Auditors are to comment on Municipal financial statements regarding possible irregularities within their audit for the municipality. Focus: changing the “may comment” to “must comment”.
- Supporting municipalities in offsite levies as a tool to help bring about better communities without current residents bearing the costs.
- Council accepted an offer for the sale of the current Fire Hall.
- Council gave first reading to a zoning change on Minto Street, where the present Fire Hall is located. The current zoning is Public Institutional to Mixed Use.
- A Public Hearing has been set for May 25, 2026 to hear comments about the proposed change being recommended. (see page 4 for details)

Development:

- Since the last council meeting there have been two additional new single-family home permits pulled.
- Melcor is moving forward on 39 more lots including single family small lot, large lot and duplexes. Development to start with underground this summer.

TOWN OF PENHOLD BYLAW NO. 848/2026 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Bylaw No. 848/2026 proposes to amend the Town's Land Use Bylaw by changing the current designation as per Bylaw 837/2025.

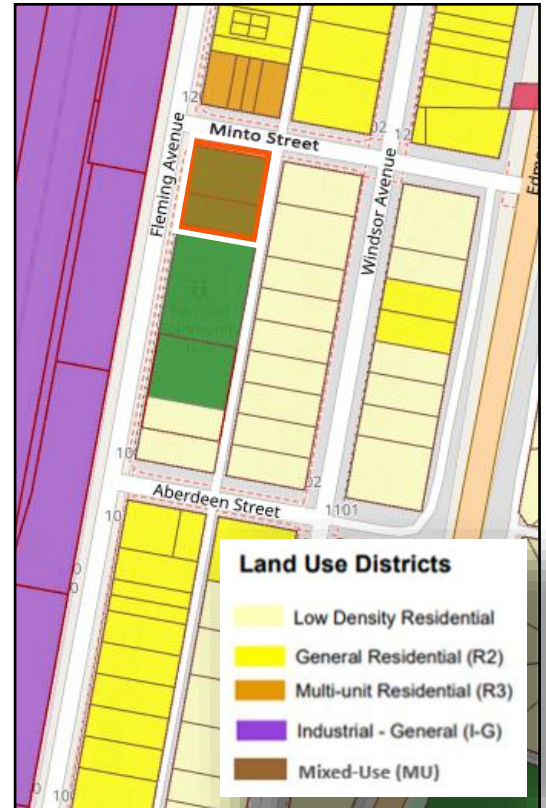
The subject land, known as the Fire Hall location, is currently designated as Public and Institutional (PI) under the Land Use Bylaw. The existing Public and Institutional designation limits the range of allowable uses and does not fully support the evolving needs and long-term development objectives of the community.

An application has been received to redesignate the subject lands to Mixed Use (MU) to allow for a combination of residential and commercial uses within an existing building. This redesignation aligns with the policies and goals of the Town of Penhold's Municipal Development Plan, including the efficient use of land, the creation of complete and vibrant activity areas, and the promotion of sustainable growth patterns.

The proposed amendment is considered consistent with adjacent land uses and is intended to integrate sensitively with surrounding developments through appropriate site design, circulation, and landscaping.

The area proposed for change is shown in orange on the drawing.

A copy of Bylaw No. 848/2026, the proposed updated version of the subject land, Plan RN26A, Block A, Lots 16-20, located at 1001 Minto Street, and the Land Use Bylaw can be viewed at the Town of Penhold Office and on the Town website (www.townofpenhold.ca).

A Public Hearing for this bylaw will be held Monday, May 25, 2026 at 6:00pm in Council Chambers at the Town Office (1 Waskasoo Avenue, Penhold Regional Multiplex, 2nd Floor, Penhold, AB). The style of the hearing will be informal and people wishing to speak will be requested to state their name and address for the record upon being recognized by the Chair.

Council will hear submissions made in person or by the agent from any person who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw. Any person wishing to submit written comments may do so by sending them to the Town Office, Attn: Development, at the address below, prior to 4:00pm on May 19, 2026. People may make oral presentations at the Council meeting, regardless of whether they have provided written comments.

2026 Property Tax Update

Town Council approved the 2026 Tax Rate Bylaw on April 27. This year, property assessment values have increased. As a result, the municipal residential mill rate has decreased, while the commercial mill rate remains unchanged.

Property taxes collected by the Town fund essential municipal services, but they also include amounts the Town is required to collect on behalf of the Province. These include the provincial education tax and policing costs, both requisitioned by the Government of Alberta, as well as the Seniors Levy, which supports the Parkland Foundation.

In total, approximately 42% of property taxes collected are remitted directly to the Province of Alberta and external organizations. Check the Town of Penhold website for more details about property taxation.

Property owners will see their individual tax amounts vary depending on changes in their property assessment. Assessment and tax details will be included in the Combined Assessment & Tax Notices distributed in May.

National Public Works Week

Join us in recognizing our Operations Team during National Public Works Week May 17–23, 2026

This year's theme “Rooted in Service, Powered by Community” acknowledges that the roots of service run deep in public works. It's what has propelled Operations innovations that have helped our communities evolve into places where people can lead lives of purpose and possibility. Some work—like building roads—is highly visible, while other Operations contributions—like maintaining water and sewer systems—are sometimes hidden from view. Together, these efforts form the foundation of thriving communities, reminding us that every project, seen or unseen, powers the connection between service and the people it supports.



Street Sweeping

The Operations department has begun its spring sweeping of medians and roadways. Please watch for No Parking signs in your area and check for postings on the Town's website and social media.

Sign up for E-News through the Town of Penhold website to find out when we will be coming to your street.

The streets will be swept periodically throughout the Town from spring until fall in problem areas without signs being posted.

Weed Control/ Spraying

You can expect to see weed spraying starting this month at various locations around Penhold. Signs will be placed advising of impacted areas. We ask that residents obey the signage and avoid the area until all signs are removed.

There are only two herbicides permitted to be used within Penhold's green spaces:

1. Premium 3 way is used on the sports fields/ green spaces to control broadleaf weeds.
2. Roundup is a non-selective herbicide used to control grass and weeds within tree/ shrub beds, flower beds and along the asphalt/ gravel pathways.

**When Roundup is being sprayed it is important NOT to walk in the area until it dries to avoid transferring the spray with each step taken after contact to unintended locations. There are many different views on the use of herbicide, please understand the Operations staff avoid using herbicide until it is deemed necessary to control weeds ie. once handpicking is no longer effective and an efficient use of time/ funds.*



Gopher Control

It's getting to be that time of year again...the gophers are popping up all over Town. The Town of Penhold has contracted Canex to help control the gopher population within Town. Medicine River Wildlife has some tips for residents on how to deter the gophers from their property. For more information on how to control gophers please check their website.

They will be located at the Northwest entrance of the Public Services Building located at 101 Waskasoo Ave (a half mile North of Oxford Blvd, east side of the road).

Once up and running accepted items in their designated bins include:

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Branches (no longer than 4 feet or 1 inch in diameter)
- No bags, garbage or animal feces are permitted in the bins.

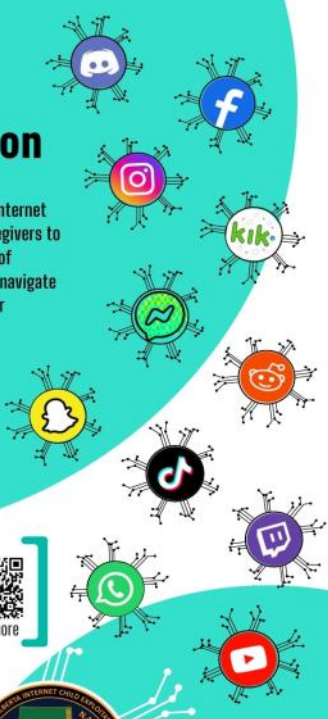


Online Safety Parent/Youth Session
